

## **CPCCWHS1001 Work safely in the construction industry**



This training program meets the needs of the construction industry and the Queensland Work Safe General Induction Training, this course is also known as the “WhiteCard” and directly aligns to the **CPCCWHS1001 Work safely in the construction industry** unit of competency.

Successful completion of this unit is mandatory before beginning work on a construction site, it is also a pre-requisite for the NSW Owner Builders Licence.

On successful completion of this training program, a participant will receive a Statement of Attainment in “**CPCCWHS1001 Work Safely in the Construction Industry**” and will be eligible to apply for a “General construction induction training card (WhiteCard)” on behalf of the Queensland work health and safety regulator.

The unit of competency is nationally recognised and can only be delivered by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) that complies with the governing standards of quality control, quality training and assessment.

A Skill Recognition process or RPL process is available for those considering seeking this qualification by demonstrating that they have attained the required skills and knowledge by other processes. These participants will be required to complete a CPSISC Recognition document, cost for this is \$120 (gst exempt), for further information please contact the CEO.

This course is offered only online, it is expected to require approximately 6 hours of effort from the participant, with most participants will be able to complete this course within one day. Enrolment is valid for six months.

Participants with prior knowledge or experience may complete the course in a shorter timeframe; participants with more limited experience in the subject matter will require longer to complete the course.

The course enrolment is valid for 6 months, thus participants undertaking this course have up to six months to complete the course.

This course is delivered online and as such requires a significant standard of English Language, Numeracy Skills and Computer proficiency.

To be successful in this course, you should be sufficiently capable in your English Language skills to:

- Read a good quality newspaper or magazine in English
- Complete calculations using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, as typically experienced in High School.

You should be computer literate to a standard to be able to:

- search the internet,
- upload and download documents,
- send emails with attachments

All training and assessment is conducted in English, and we will enquire using our enrolment form as to your standard of written and verbal English.

We will assist you with your English standards, such as providing word definitions and meanings, additional explanation of assessment requirements, however should your needs for support or assistance exceed our skills, we will refer you to a suitable organisation to assist you further.

As the course is online, participants in this course must have access to:

- A modern computer equipped with:
  - access to the internet

- Skype or similar agreed to video conferencing software
- a web cam
- a printer
- a video camera (such as one built into a “smart phone”)
- Support person able to assist with videoing of assessment activities

The online course allows for a participant, once registered and enrolled, to access through their own computer via the internet, our online course materials so they can acquire the skills and knowledge required for the assessments for this unit of competency.

The participant will be supported by our highly qualified trainers who will offer support by email and telephone.

The support will allow the participant to be mentored and supported as they learn

Should there be another way we can assist you with ensuring that you maximise your chances of completing the course, though us changing some aspect of the course or accommodating your special needs please call our Administration Staff.

### **Enrolment Process:**

As the course is only offered online, applicants will initially express interest in our course, through one of:

- Online registration (expression of interest)
- Email to our administration office
- Telephone call to our administration office.

All applicants will be provided with the course flyer, the enrolment application form, which includes payment options, and the participant handbook, through either download or email.

Completed applications, including confirmation of acceptance of our terms and conditions, completed payment method, provision of Photo ID, and proof of age are returned to our office.

Successfully completed applications, that contain all required information and demonstrate that the applicant meet all of our requirements will be accepted and the applicant will be considered enrolled and thus be termed a participant in our course.

To be eligible to enrol in this training program, participants must be over 14 years of age, (Note : Participants under 18 years of age are not eligible to enrol, and will not be accepted, into the NSW Owner Builder course.) Participants must be able to demonstrate to us, via secure upload at time of enrolment suitable forms of ID (See <https://www.worksafe.qld.gov.au/licensing-and-registrations/work-health-and-safety-licences/apply-renew-or-replace-licences/proof-of-identification> for details as to what ID is awarded what points.

Should a participant not be successful in an attempt at completing the course, they will be allowed additional opportunities without additional charge.

Due to the requirements of maintaining a safe learning environment, 1010 ID Pty Ltd reserves the right to withdraw any participant(s) on the grounds of safety; this includes bullying, cyber bullying or other unacceptable online behaviour.

**Fees and Charges:** The fee for this course is \$60 and is GST exempt. The fee is due only at the course completion.

Participants are able to enrol in the course, complete the learning sections, sit the online and interview assessments, and only when found competent are required to pay for the course. As such there are no refunds.

All fees can be paid by credit card or EFT.

All Participants should note that lost statements of attainment can be replaced, the fee for this is \$35 and will require the participant to advise of their name and other suitable personal details to allow us to confirm their identity.

Participants who lose their “WhiteCard” will need to contact Queensland Work Safe directly.
